The Junior Citizenship DVD Resource presents the authentic experience of children. They are shown understanding and participating in the democratic process; speaking, listening and representing skills as well as developing the confidence to express emotions and feelings.

- **School council elections:** Two schools are shown. **Teaching Points:** Each step of the election process, representing others, reaching agreement and changing a school by participation and involvement.
- **School councils in action & briefing the class representative:** Three school councils, with different approaches and structures, make decisions that affect their schools. **Teaching Points:** Comparing the three school councils in terms of how they function, are chaired and managed, the issues discussed and the decisions made. Representing other people's views and feeding back the decisions of the council to the class.
- **Circle time:** Three circles are shown at work. The children explain how the circle has enabled them to resolve emotional and social problems in a safe and supportive environment. **Teaching Points:** The importance of allowing feelings to be expressed and conflicts to be resolved and using the collective strength of the class to resolve problems.

- **The buddy system:** Children explain the buddy system. **Teaching Points:** The qualities that make a good buddy and the problems they can resolve.
- **Mediation:** Children are shown being trained to act as mediators in playground disputes using active listening skills and not taking sides in helping disputants reach a resolution they value. **Teaching Points:** Resolving conflict by exploring feelings and emotions using listening skills, commitment and perseverance.
- **Life skills:** Three active child-centred learning activities that promote caring for others, self-management and team work. Young Lifesavers, the School Office, the Tuck Shop. **Teaching Points:** Working without supervision in an adult environment, developing telephone and communication skills, the benefits of working as a team, learning life-saving skills to care for others in a crisis.
